The "Ausschuss für Umwelt- und Ressourcenökonomie (AURÖ) im Verein für Socialpolitik" and the Institute of Environmental Systems Research and Department of Economics at Osnabrück University cordially invite you to the annual workshop "Environmental and Resource Economics". The workshop takes place at Osnabrück University.

The workshop is aimed at young researchers (PhD students and Postdocs), especially from Germany, Austria and Switzerland, and welcomes contributions from all fields of environmental and resource economics. As every year, the workshop offers the opportunity to present one's own research to a small, professionally qualified audience and to discuss it with others. In addition, the workshop offers the opportunity to establish contacts with other young scientists in German-speaking countries and exchange experiences.

The workshop will be led by the Alexander von Humboldt- Professorship for Environmental Economics (Prof. Stefanie Engel and her team), with support from Prof. Robert Gillenkirch, Department of Business Administration and Economics (Osnabrück University) and Prof. Andreas Löschel of the Centre of Applied Economic Research Münster (University of Münster).

Workshop language is English. Submissions and presentations can be in German.

Fees: There are no conference fees. The costs of travel and accommodation are covered by the participants themselves. The workshop reception and dinner on 22 Feb. 2018 are free of charge for participants.

Submission of contributions by 3 December 2017 should be in the form of a meaningful abstract of approx. 1-2 pages outlining the question, method and (expected) results. The abstract must contain the title of the contribution, as well as the name, institutional affiliation and email address of all authors. It should be in PDF format and submitted by email to katharina.hembach@uni-osnabrueck.de.

By 18 December 2017, the person submitting the abstract will be informed if his or her contribution has been accepted for the workshop.
